## **DMCI AACE Award Nomination Criteria**

There are five categories open for nominations. A selection committee of alumni members will review all nominations received and determine award recipients.

### *Nominators:*

Anyone can nominate an individual. People are welcome to nominate themselves.

### *Nominees:*

1. Must have attended Daniel McIntyre Collegiate Institute as a student for a minimum of one year or taught or served as an administrator at the school for a minimum of five years.
2. Special consideration will be given to individuals who have also had a significant impact on Daniel McIntyre Collegiate Institute through volunteer or financial contributions.
3. First consideration will be given to graduates.
4. Current members of the DMCI Alumni Board are not eligible.
5. Individuals may be nominated for more than one category but will only be selected for one award per ceremony.

## **Categories**

### **1. ATHLETIC ACHIEVEMENT**

Nominees must have been involved in the DMCI sports program and have ongoing involvement as an athlete, coach, official or volunteer in the community.

Individuals must possess the following qualities:

- Leadership
- Teamwork
- Respect
- Communication skills
- Strong work ethic
- Mentors others in athletic excellence and participation

## 2. ARTS

Nominees must have experience in the visual/media/performing/literary arts either through employment and/or volunteer work.

Individuals must possess the following qualities:

- Artistic achievement in their chosen field
- Dedication to cultural life/events within their community
- Mentors others in the pursuit of artistic excellence
- Respect

## 3. COMMUNITY SERVICE

Nominees must have experience in community service (i.e. the delivery of services that help to create safe, healthy, vibrant communities and have a lasting/significant impact on the well-being of its citizens) in one or both of the following areas:

*Volunteer Stream:* Community service is not part of the individual's job description or duties and does not involve any financial remuneration

*Employment Stream:* Through the individual's employment or business/organization they provide a community service(s) to their local community.

Individuals must possess the following qualities:

- Compassion for others
- Leadership
- Commitment
- Respect
- Exemplifies the spirit of community service
- Mentors others in the pursuit of community service either through volunteering or employment

#### **4. LIFE TIME SERVICE**

Nominees must have a minimum of 25 years' experience and contributions within one of the following areas: athletics, arts, education or community service.

Individuals must possess the following qualities:

- Leadership
- Commitment
- Respect
- Teamwork
- Mentorship

#### **5. YOUTH**

Nominees must have graduated from DMCI within the last five years and be under the age of 25. Individuals must have a minimum of three years volunteer experience with an organization that focuses on community service.

Individuals must possess the following qualities:

- Leadership
- Initiative
- Dedication
- Responsibility
- Teamwork

**FOR ALL CATEGORIES:** Other related education, recognition, accomplishments and/or contributions, and years of experience will be considered.
