## **Annual Meeting Highlights**

The DMCI Alumni Association held its annual general meeting on April 24, 2006 at the school. President Doug Sargeant opened the meeting by noting a number of the highlights from the year including successful fundraising efforts like the Bud, Spud and Steak event held in October 2005, the purchase of the universal gym at the school—funded in part by a donation from the alumni association, and ongoing work to regularly update the alumni web site for the benefit of past and present students. The meeting also featured reports from the archival, fundraising, newsletter, scholarship and nominating committees as well as the Treasurer's Report.

The board said thank you and farewell to two departing members, Ted Letkemann who had served as a member-at-large since 2002 and Ione McMahon who had been Treasurer. Ted was an enthusiastic board member who gave generously of his time during numerous alumni activities and fundraising events. His commitment to the school was evident throughout his tenure. Ione served as Treasurer of the alumni association since its inception in the 1980s, taking a brief hiatus in the late 1990s. She spent countless hours keeping the financial records accurate and up-to-date, issuing receipts, investing funds and keeping the board apprised of all donations and expenditures. She attended all of the fundraising events, acting as the “bank” on a number of occasions. Her dedication and loyalty to the Daniel McIntyre population will be missed as well as her knowledge of fiscal matters as they pertain to the school. The contributions of board member John Lawler, who passed away suddenly in November 2005, were also remembered, particularly his work on the archival committee. John had been a staff representative on the board.

Mary Capri was elected as a new board member. Cindy Harris, who joined the board in November

2005 was elected Treasurer, and Franco Petrelli who became a member of the board at least year's

annual meeting, was elected Vice-President. Returning members are: Doug Sargeant, President; Joyce Wawrykow, Past President; Gilles Beaumont, DMCI Principal; Heather Johnson, Secretary; Bill Kilfoyle and Grant Sims, Members-at-Large; and Mary Kelekis, Honorary Life Member. Staff Representatives are Bev Sorensen and Marina McCaffrey. Marina joined the board in February following the death of John Lawler.

### **By-law Changes**

The following by-law changes were passed at the annual meeting.

#### **Item 3.02 (c) Composition**

*Previously stated:*

The vice-president, who shall be the current principal of Daniel McIntyre Collegiate Institute or such person as the principal shall designate to act in her or his stead.

*Change:*

The vice-president (remainder of text above is deleted).

#### **Item 3.02 (f) Composition**

*Previously stated:*

Two persons who are members of the organization by virtue of Clause 2.01(a)(iii) or associate members by virtue of clause 2.02(a)(ii) of this By-Law.

*Change:*

Three members-at-large, one of who must be the current principal or his/her designate, who are members of the organization by virtue of Clause

2.01(a)(iii) or associate members by virtue of clause 2.02(a)(ii) of this By-Law.

### **Item 3.02 (g) Composition**

*Previously stated:*

Five other members of the organization

*Change:*

Four other members of the organization

### **Item 3.03 (a) Election and Term**

*Previously stated:*

The election of directors, including officers, shall take place at an annual meeting of the members, and all directors then in office, whose term(s) have expired, shall retire; but, if qualified, shall be eligible for re-election provided that the director has not served for six consecutive years. The director shall again be eligible for re-election after an absence of at least one year from the Board of Directors. The members of the Board of Directors shall take office immediately upon election.

*Change:*

The election of directors, including officers, shall take place at an annual meeting of the members, and all directors then in office, whose term(s) have expired, shall retire; but, if qualified, shall be eligible for re-election.

### **Item 3.06 Meetings of Directors**

*Previously stated:*

Meetings of the Board shall be held as often as may be required, but at least once every three months, and shall be called by the President. A special meeting of the Board may be called upon the written request of any two members thereof with such written request to state the business to be brought before the meeting. Meetings may be held without notice if a quorum of the Board is present; provided, however, that any business transacted at

such meeting shall be null and void unless ratified at the next regularly called meeting of the Board.

*Change:*

Meetings of the Board shall be held as often as may be required, but a minimum of three per year. A special meeting of the Board may be called upon the written request of any two members thereof with such written request to state the business to be brought before the meeting. Meetings may be held without notice if a quorum of the Board is present; provided, however, that any business transacted at such meeting shall be null and void unless ratified at the next regularly called meeting of the Board.

### **Item 5.03 Officers: Vice-President**

*Previously stated:*

The Vice-President shall be a director, and shall have such duties and powers as the directors may specify and delegate. During the absence or incapacity of the President his or her duties and powers shall be exercised by the Vice-President.

*Change:*

The Vice-President, the president elect, shall be a director, and shall have such duties and powers as the directors may specify and delegate. During the absence or incapacity of the President his or her duties and powers shall be exercised by the Vice-President.

### **Item 12.0 Dissolution**

*Previously stated:*

Upon the dissolution of the organization, the property of the organization shall be converted into cash and added to the funds of the organization and the amount thereof distributed firstly in payment of all outstanding debts and liabilities of the organization and the balance shall be distributed to or for the benefit of the Daniel McIntyre Collegiate Institute, or a successor institution.

*Change:*

Upon the dissolution of the organization, the property of the organization shall be converted into cash and added to the funds of the organization and



the amount thereof distributed firstly in payment of all outstanding debts and liabilities of the organization and the balance shall be paid over to the Winnipeg School Division's Children's Heritage Fund or another qualified donee to be administered for the benefit of Daniel McIntyre Collegiate Institute or a successor institution.
